Daniel, Brooklyn born, now-retired police officer, helped bring the country an uplifting spirit of promise and hope with his stirring rendition of "God Bless America" after the 2001 World Trade Center terrorist attack.

On September 11, 2001, Officer Rodriguez was driving to work when the first plane hit the World Trade Center. Arriving at the site as a first-responder, he witnessed the destruction of both towers, nearly losing his own life. At "Prayer for America" in Yankee Stadium his inspirational voice gave hope and strength to a grieving nation.

His music career had turned into a calling.

Daniel's philanthropic and patriotic efforts have been recognized with numerous honors, such as the USO Lifetime Achievement Award, the DAR Medal of Patriotism and others. He continues to uplift and inspire in performances for his chosen charities, and at concert halls around the world.

FEBRUARY CHAIRMAN'S BRIEFING

Orange County Republicans are ready and united! This month has been very productive for our party as we charge forward to the June primary and November general election.

Our team is in daily communication and coordination with our partners on the national, state and local levels.

The Yorba Linda Republican field office is up and running as a collaborative effort with the California Republican Party to protect Congressional District 39 and flip Senate District 29. Soon we will have a Republican field office in every targeted Congressional District where we will see united Republican efforts until November.

In fact, this past weekend we trained over 100 Republican volunteers through the Republican Leadership Initiative training in the Yorba Linda field office and Tustin headquarters. The training was taught and coordinated by the Republican National Committee and California Republican Party. Due to the unprecedented response we will be announcing a third training in a few weeks.

Our Central Committee met twice this month. On the 19th we heard from Senate Republican Leader Pat Bates who shared the pathway to ending the Democrats' failed super majority in the Senate. We also heard from our

State College Republican Chairman - Ariana Rowlands, and candidate for Attorney General Eric Early. We also endorsed in three non-partisan seats. On the 26th we had a special session on endorsements for certain partisan seats. It was a packed house on both occasions as we endorsed strong Orange County Republicans on the federal, state and local levels.

At those meetings, I was proud to announce that at our 19th Annual Flag Day Salute we will honor Representative Ed Royce with the Thomas A. Fuentes Award for his legacy of leadership in Orange County. We will also welcome Turning Point USA founder Charlie Kirk as one of our featured speakers.

I was also proud to share another accomplishment - to date we have raised over \$175,000 for our 19th Annual Flag Day Salute. Never have we secured such an investment for our annual event so early, and we're not done yet.

That is Republican energy and support you can take to the bank, literally.

While we are moving forward with full force to the midterms, the Democrats ran into trouble this weekend at their disastrous state convention. California Democrats are so divided they could not agree on an endorsement in the Governor's race or the targeted open Orange County congressional seats. In fact, they couldn't even agree on endorsing Senator Feinstein for a sixth term.

I want to thank every single person who since January 1 has stepped up and been ready for the 2018 fight. Your energy, enthusiasm and support will lead us to victory in June and November.
